Eligible charitable organizations seeking funding from Brookfield Properties should follow the instructions below.

All funding proposals should include the following information:

- Copy of 501(c)(3) or Charitable Registration Number
- Amount of funding requested
- Description of organization and programs
- List of Board of Directors
- History of past support by or relationship with Brookfield Properties
- Potential volunteer opportunities for Brookfield Properties employees
- Additional partnership benefits for Brookfield Properties

All completed proposals from eligible charitable organizations will be considered and decided on by appropriate business units within the company. Approved funding will

be disbursed on an annual basis. Brookfield Properties will not commit to multi-year funding agreements.

Those organizations which meet initial grant requirements may be asked to meet members of Brookfield's Strategic Philanthropy Committee in-person to discuss details of the partnership before a final decision on support is made.

Brookfield Properties does not support:

- An individual person or family;
- Consultants, advisors, or any others who furnish professional services to Brookfield;
- Religious organizations;
- Labor organizations;
- Political parties, candidates or campaigns;
- Endowment or personal memorial funds.
