Making recycling second nature at Brookfield Place

In your lunchroom:

Blue Bin:

- ▶ glass, plastic bottles, cans, coffee cups

Organic or Green Bin:

- ▶ coffee grounds and organics

At your desk, small recycle box:

- ▶ newspapers, magazines and telephone books
- ▶ all types of paper, paper reports with staples and binder clips
- ▶ shredded paper
- ▶ all envelopes, labels and post-it-notes
- ▶ cardboard and corrugated

At the security desk, ground floor, front lobby:

- ▶ batteries, cell phones, and PDA's

At the loading dock

- ▶ lamps, bulbs & ballasts, scrap metal, wood skids, bread trays, milk crates and inkjet cartridges
- ▶ fryer oil/grease
- ▶ e-waste - computers, TV's, Printers, etc.

Waste:

- ▶ rubberbands, carbon paper, napkins, facial tissue, foil, plastic wrap, styrofoam, grocery bags and waxed cardboard
